Hyundai: A Global Design

Maple-Leaf Construction has completed the new Nashua Hyundai Dealership for long-time client, The Thompson Automotive Group. What began as the demolition of their former dealership in early May 2015 has evolved into one of the few pilot dealership Hyundai Facilities completed in the United States to date.

The current design—called the Global Dealership Space Identity—is aimed at creating a unified look at all Hyundai dealerships before the end of the decade. While replacing the silver exterior and blue accents, the global design program features an open, airy showroom with high ceilings and floor-to-ceiling glass, topped by a bronze-colored roof structure.
